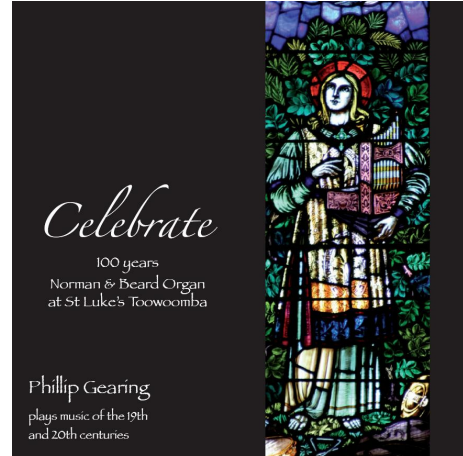


Celebrate
